One of the windows may still be seen in the west wall of the tower at St Nicholas' Church, Teddington, where it was re-used in 1567 after the demolition of Hailes.. The comparative dating suggests that this window jamb stone may derive originally from the new Lady Chapel built at Winchcombe under Abbot John Yanworth (c.1275-80).
